Central Utah Advocate

Duties

Provide direct advocacy services in the Central Utah region. Services may include:

- Provide emotional support to victims
- Conduct intake interviews and safety planning
- Respond to crisis calls
- Assist victims with filing protective orders and other legal proceedings
- Accompany victims to hospitals, police stations, court houses, and safe shelters
- Provide information and referral for medical, legal services, counseling, and case management services
- Assist with setting up informational booths at fairs and help with planning community awareness events and workshops
- Participate in crisis response team meetings
- Maintain and update client files
- Other duties as assigned

Required Qualifications

- Bachelor's Degree preferred (will consider H.S. degree with equivalent work/life experience)
- Good listening and crisis intervention skills
- Ability to deal with traumatic events
- Training and presenting skills
- Knowledge and experience with computers (PowerPoint, Excel, etc)
- Fluent in American Sign Language and knowledge of Deaf Culture
- Experience and knowledge of helping victims of domestic violence and sexual assault
- Knowledge of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA Law)
- Have a current driver's license and be able to travel
- Must pass a criminal background check
